Brick Campaign for Michael Horrocks Memorial

West Chester University is creating a permanent statute to honor Michael Horrocks, a 1985 alum of West Chester. First Officer Horrocks was the First Officer on United Flight 175 who tragically died on September 11, 2001.

A life-sized bronze statue of Mike, who played football for West Chester, will be erected at the foot of the hill which leads to the football field. It will be surrounded by a brick landscape and will be a focal point of pre-game fan activities as well as an inspiration to current players as they take the field on Saturday afternoons.

While the school has funds to begin construction, it needs additional funds to complete the landscaping surrounding the statue. Brick pavers are being incorporated on the ground surrounding the statue and are available for personal inscription as a way to help fund the completion of the construction.
