### **United Airlines Pilots Announce Agreement in Principle with Company**

ROSEMONT (Ill.) – Today, the pilots at United Airlines, represented by the Air Line Pilots Association, Int'l (ALPA), announced an agreement in principle (AIP) with the Company on comprehensive new terms for their collective bargaining agreement.

Over the coming weeks, the AIP will be finalized into contract language for consideration by the United ALPA Master Executive Council (UAL MEC). If accepted, details will be released to all United pilots for final review and membership ratification.

“The professionalism of United pilots throughout these negotiations has been extraordinary, especially during the global pandemic and largest disruption in the history of commercial aviation,” said UAL MEC Chair Capt. Michael Hamilton. “That focus has helped us reach an industry leading agreement that recognizes our contributions to the current and future success of United Airlines.”
