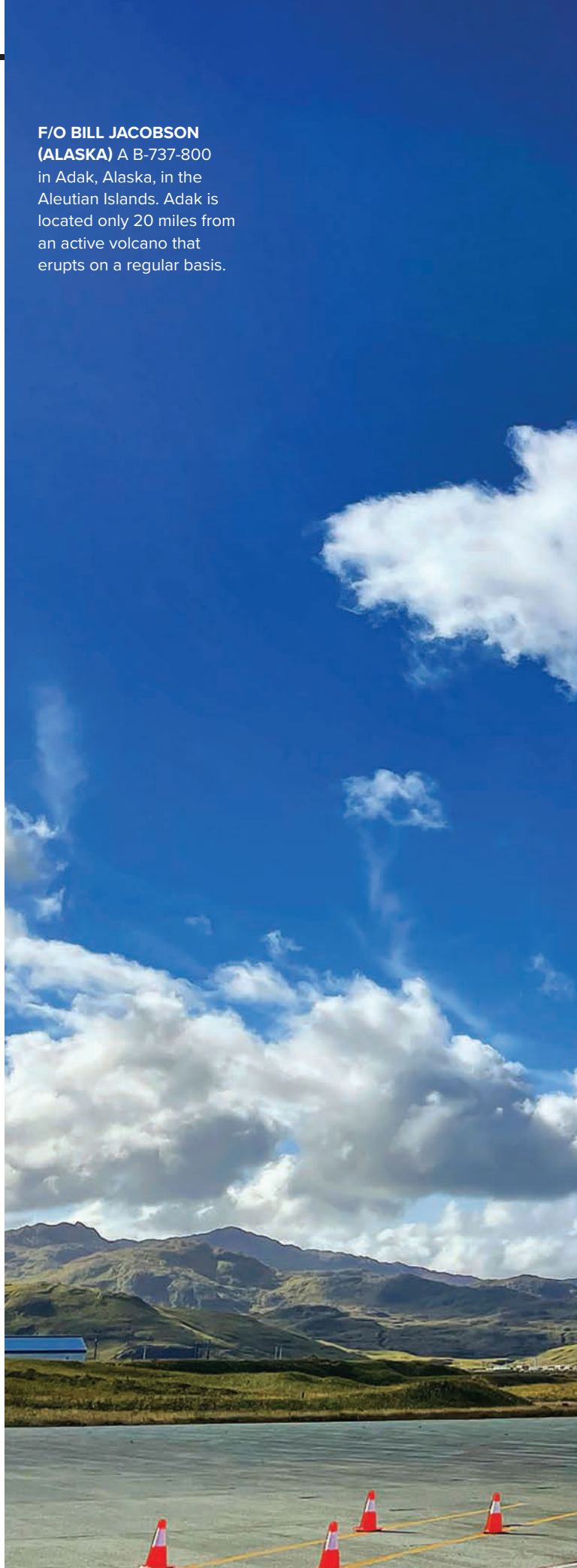
11th Annual PILOT PHOTOGRAPHY ISSUE

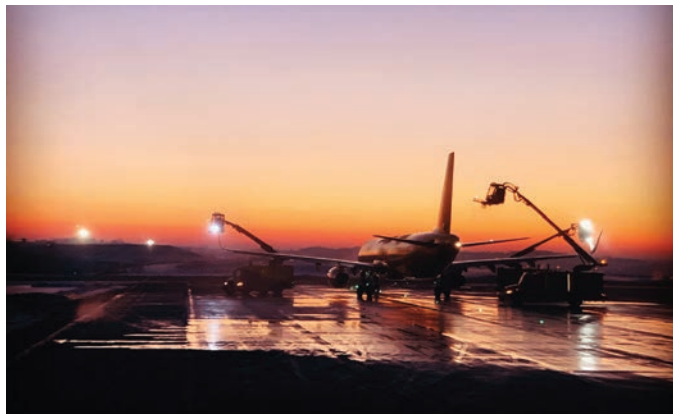

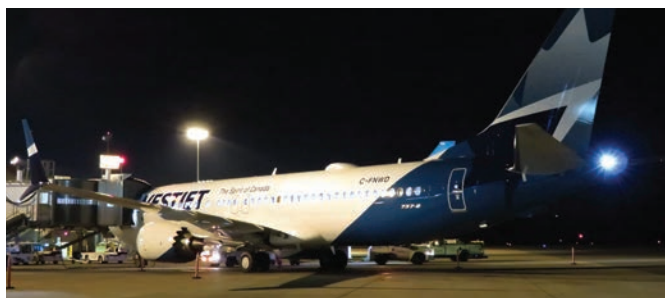
